2. E.A.S.I.E. Part II Closes May 16th - Sonia shared that the budget needs to be written for Part II.

- 3. Graduation Rate: Bemidji Area Schools, ISD #31 student's graduation rate were discussed, and the American Indian Students graduation gap widens. Sonia talked about some of the barriers for the students, they are such things as transportation for extracurricular activities, mental health, lack of any support, 11th -12th grade dropout year, the rigor increases from 8 to 9 grade and the reality that everything counts toward graduation. Discussed on how to help with these barriers. After many ideas were shared on what to do and what is already being done in our district, it was decided Jordan and Sonia would put together a short-term plan. The short-term plan will look at goals and a time line for those goals, keeping the budget in mind, also keeping in mind that small changes still can take time. These will be ideas for principals and staff to implement into schools and classrooms on a more immediate basis. An important thing the board kept coming back to was the relationship staff have with students and families and then the relationship students and families have with staff. Building those relationships and the importance of them.
